## What We Do

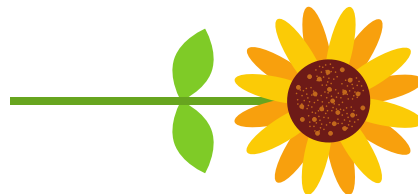
Four book sales per year

## History of the Mountain Home Public Library

In 1903, village Trustees appointed the first Board of Directors and a public reading room was created in Mountain Home. In 1908, equipped with only a furnace and the book collection, a permanent Library, funded by Andrew Carnegie building to set up shop across town at a newly constructed site. Over the next 30 years, space was once again at a premium and voters passed a second bond initiative which doubled the size of the existing building. The newly renovated building reopened on March 17th 2006.

Mountain Home Public Library continues to expand its book collection as well as electronic resources and tech offerings. The Library provides a public computer center, WiFi access and bilingual assistance along with a Commons Area, a coffee bar and outdoor patio seating. There is also a public conference room available to rent and a variety of adult and childrens' events throughout the year.
